This report was created by Deque Systems Inc. upon completion of an accessibility evaluation performed in January of 2026. The latest validation of issues was performed in the month of March 2026.

Evaluation Methods Used:

A combination of automated and manual testing techniques was employed for the accessibility assessment

- Manual assessment was performed using Chrome v144.0.7559.110 on Windows 11 and included exclusive use of the keyboard.
- Automated tools used included axe Auditor and the axe DevTools browser extension using axe-core version 4.10.3.
- Assistive technologies employed included NVDA v.2025.3.2.
