As a community Council we would like to know the crime statistics for the following beat areas. These should be identified by crime i.e. road traffic incident; house breaking; vandalism; misuse of drugs; assault. These should cover the months of January and February 2016

Please also state the amount of detections in each category.

These statistics are required for Beat nos. 31; 32; 33 and 34 which cover our community council area.

In response, I have attached all crimes recorded under beats GB31 to GB34 at the end of this response.

If you are not satisfied with the way in which your request has been dealt with, you are entitled in the first instance, and within 40 working days of receiving this response, to request a review of the decision.
