Police Report:

PC Richardson read through the crime report for the area covering the month of September with a total of 140 calls.

Beat 31 - Kennishead/Carnwadric/ Regents Park there were 26 crime reports.

Beat 32 – Arden there were 27 crime reports.

Various types of crime in the area were discussed but assurances of no major crimes or unusual behaviour.

Residents informed police of recent activity in the KG V park resulting in youths setting fires. Also reports of noisy and speeding vehicles along Boydstone Road late at night.

Community Business:

Y Henderson was in attendance at the last Community Council Development Day held in John Street, Saturday 17th Sept. The CC now has the authority to have a say on local planning and licensing applications and we should be kept informed of anything occurring in the area.

Bailie Docherty:

Bailie Docherty reported that the 2nd half of Boydstone Road is due to be resurfaced.

Aberlour have had a Friday club running in the Carnwadric Community Hall for the past few weeks and hopes are that it may continue (funding permitting).

The Newlands/Auldburn council ward is being changed to take in Arden. The New Glasgow Council Boundaries will result in 85 councillors representing 7 3-member wards and 16 4-member wards, increasing councillor numbers in the Glasgow area by 6.

Cllr. Curran:

Councillor Curran replied to the question of weeds and overgrown areas. LES can only spray the weeds etc weather permitting and it seem that this has been has been unsuccessful over the past months.

Attended the Glen Oaks AGM last week which was very successful and looking forward to attending the official opening of the refurbished Carnwadric Community Halls.

A.O.C.B.

Community complaints regarding communal bins not being emptied properly. This results in the bins being left week after week with rotting refuse. This is especially prevalent in the Bangorshill Street area. We were informed that there is new personnel in the Bin service department and Bailie Docherty will take the matter up with them.

Carnwadric Community Hall is now refurbished and already planning new clubs/lets for the area. It is hoped this will hall will be an asset to the community.
