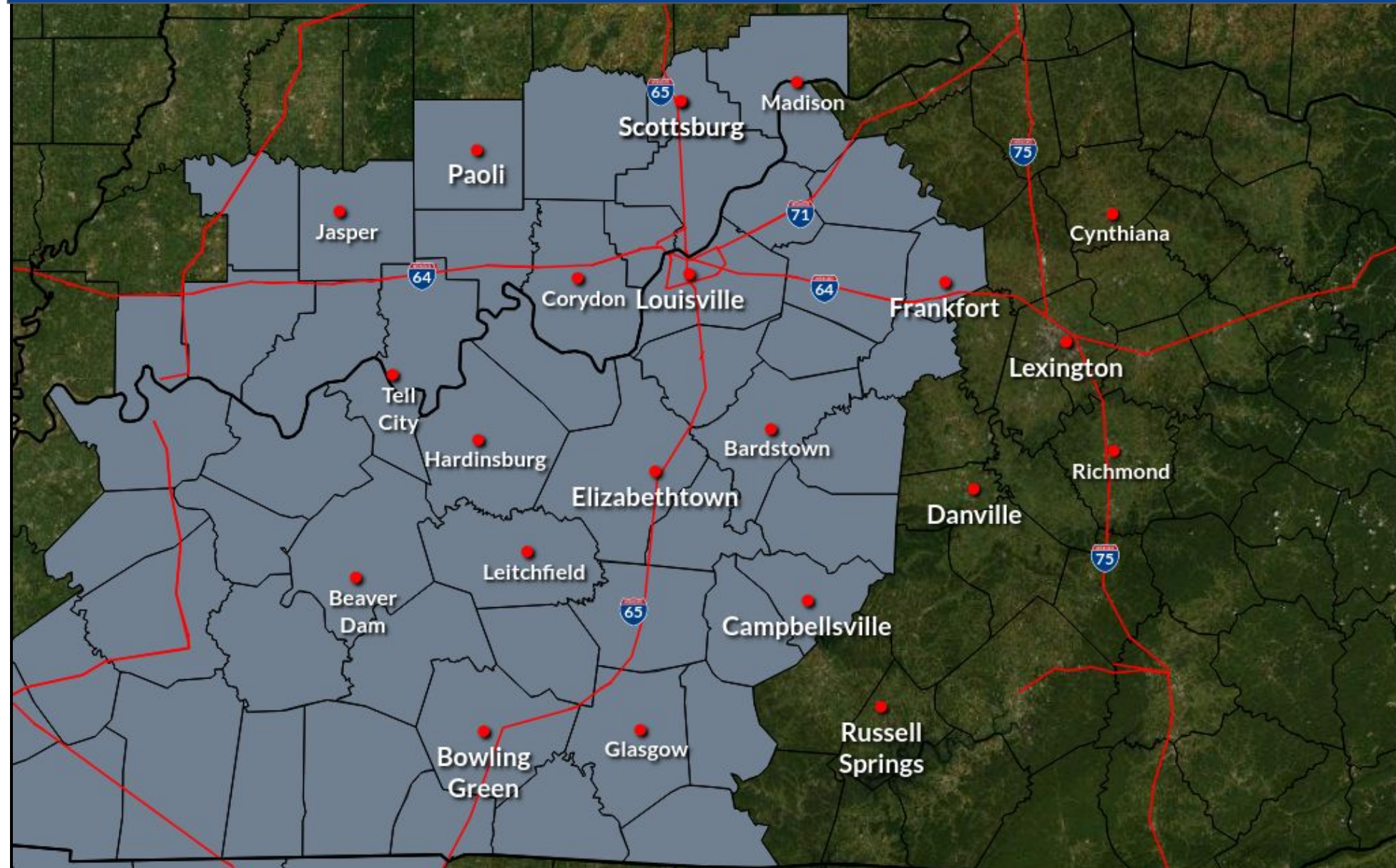
Today and Sunday

Severe Storms Possible Monday Night

Late Monday night into early Tuesday morning

Key Messages:

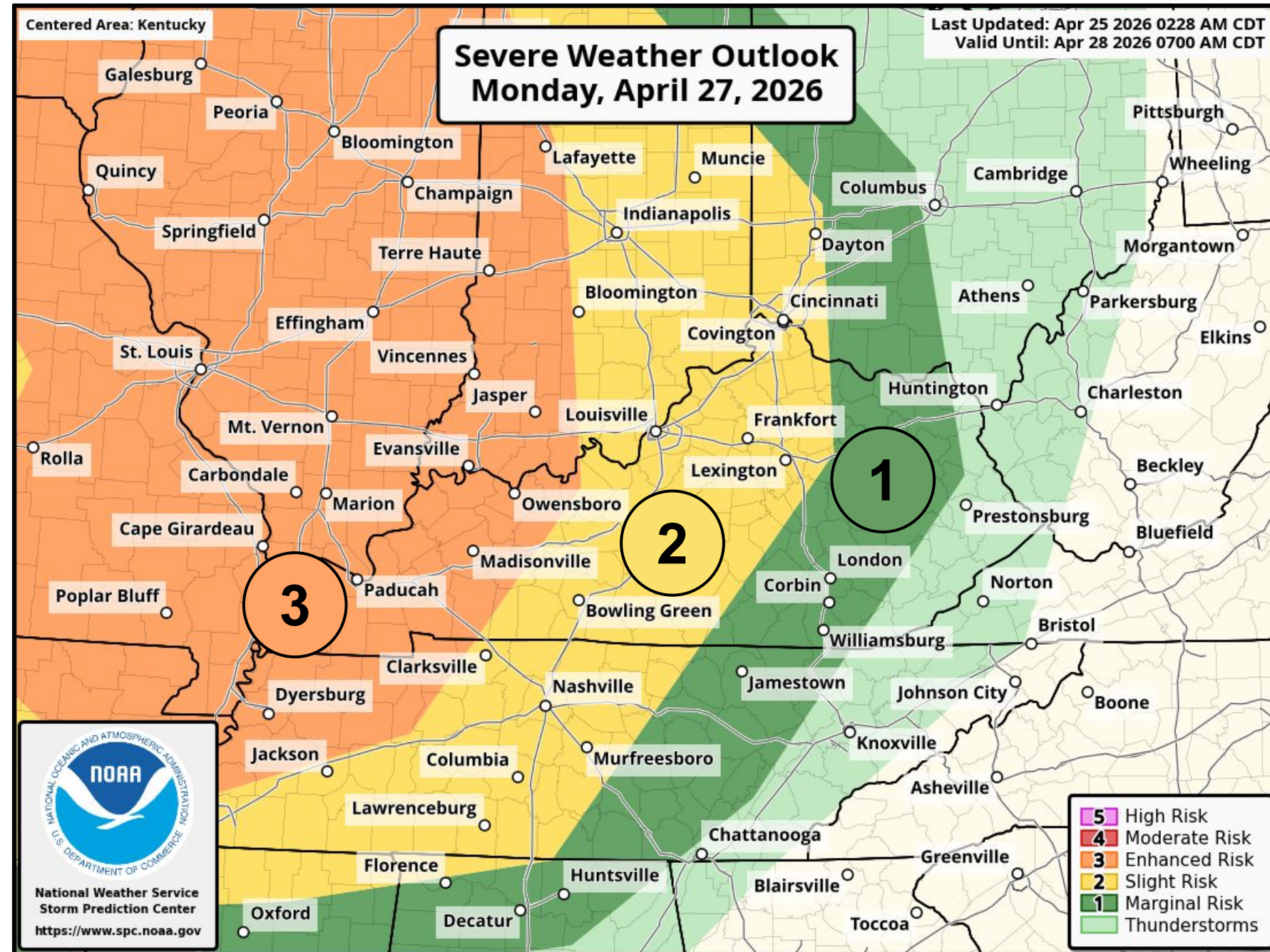
- **What:** Strong to severe storms
- **When:** Monday night into early Tuesday morning.
- **Where:** Largest threat for severe weather is along and west of I-65.
- **Actions:**
 - Monitor forecast updates this weekend
 - This will be a nighttime event, plan accordingly



What Has Changed

- Recent trends have shifted the greatest severe storm potential *later* Monday night into early Tuesday morning.

Severe Weather Probabilities

- Greatest threat for severe weather will be along and west of I-65.
- As the storms approach central Kentucky and southern Indiana, lack of daytime heating will allow storms to weaken.
 - **Uncertainty:** How far storms will progress eastward before weakening below severe thresholds.

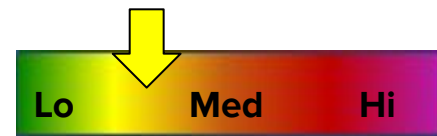

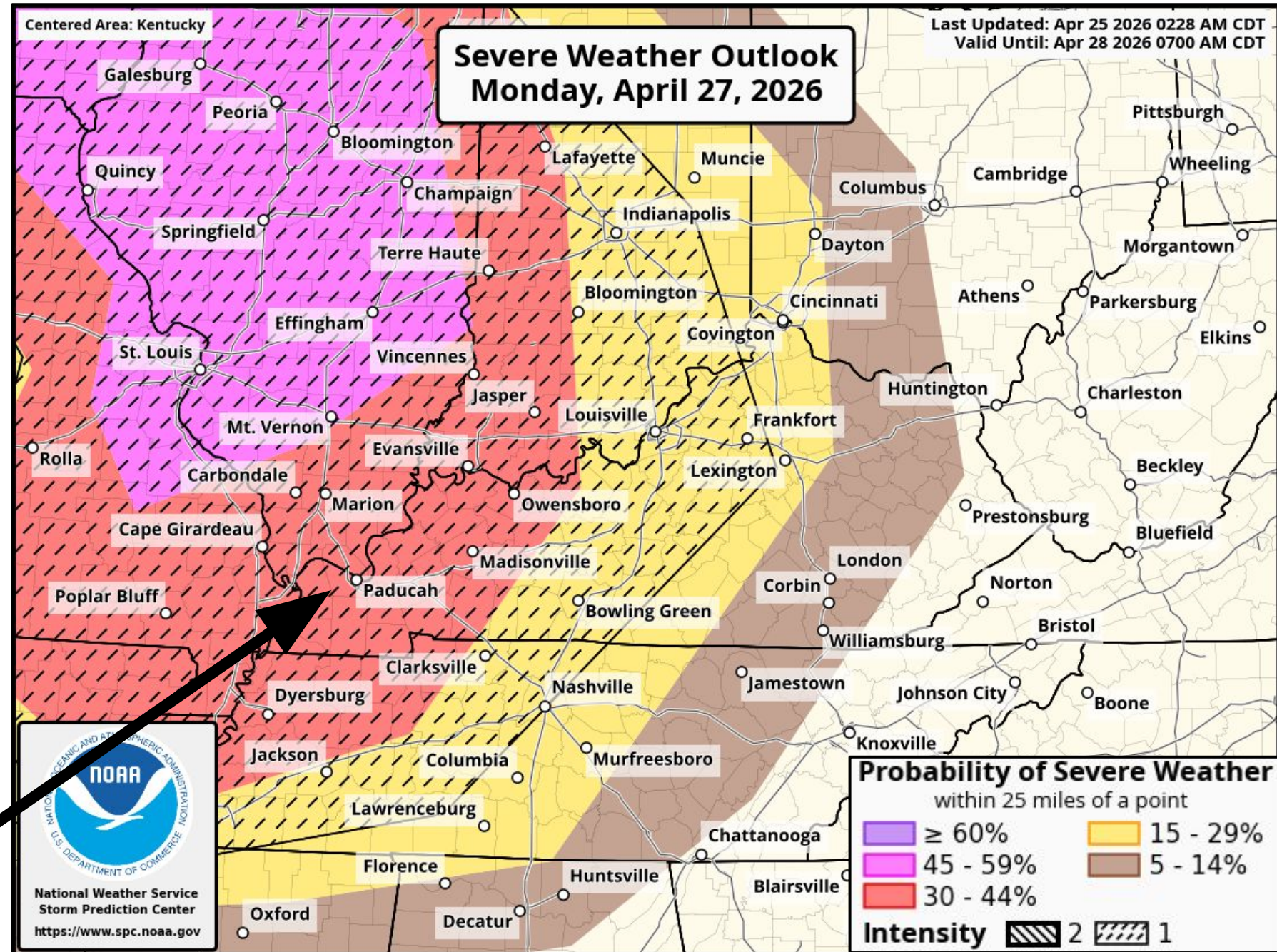

Rainfall Forecast

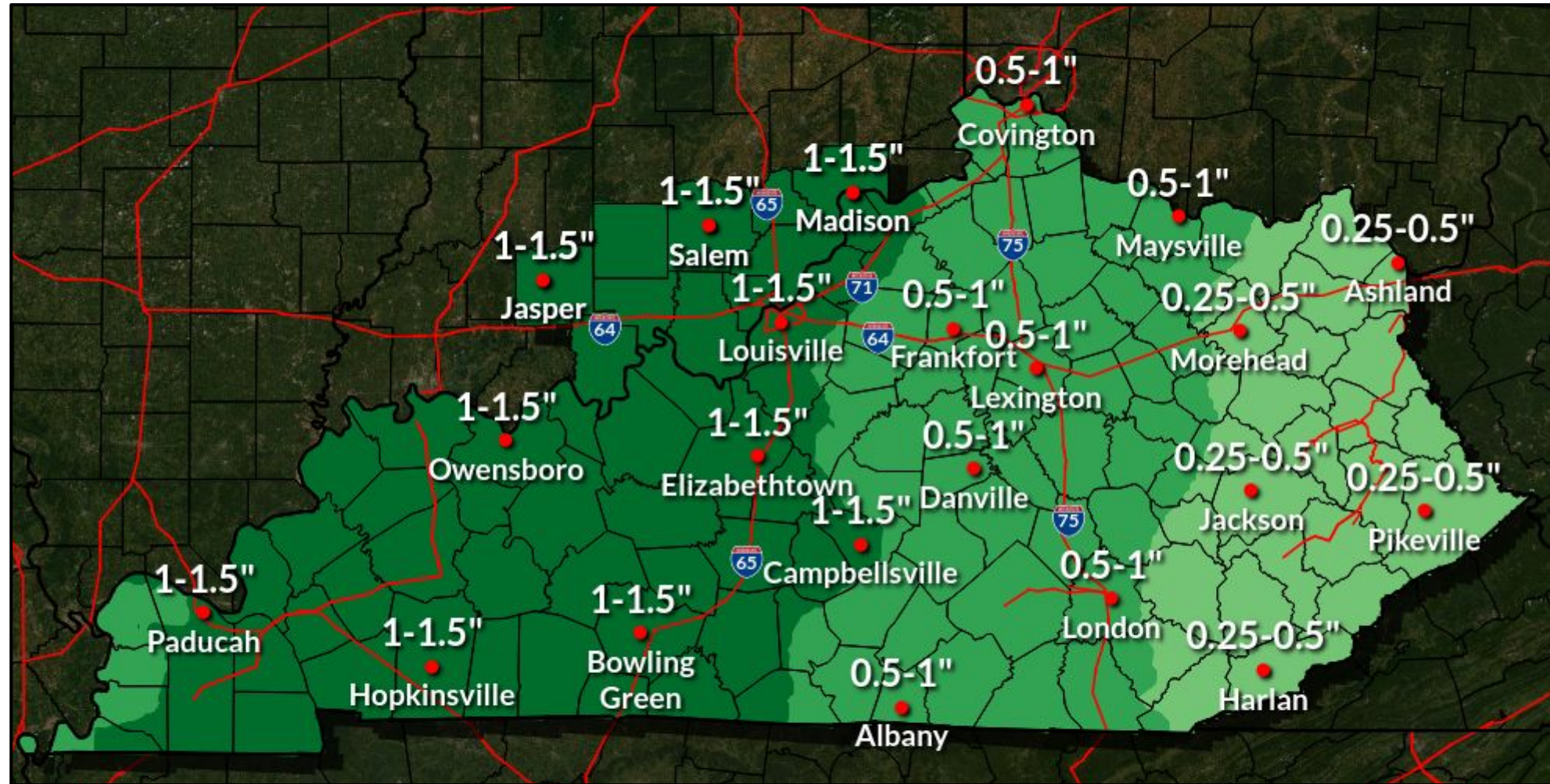
April 25, 2026

Late Monday night into early Tuesday morning

Key Messages:

- Heavy rainfall may bring brief ponding and minor flooding.
- A much needed widespread 0.5-1.5 inches is expected.
- Localized areas may see higher totals.

Below Normal Temperatures Ahead

April 25, 2026

Late Next Week

Key Messages:

- A stronger cold front is expected to bring cooler air later next week.
- Cooler than normal temperatures are expected:
 - ◆ Normal High Temperature = 74F
 - ◆ Current High Forecast = mid 60s
 - ◆ Normal Low Temperature = 54F
 - ◆ Current Low Forecast = mid 40s
